

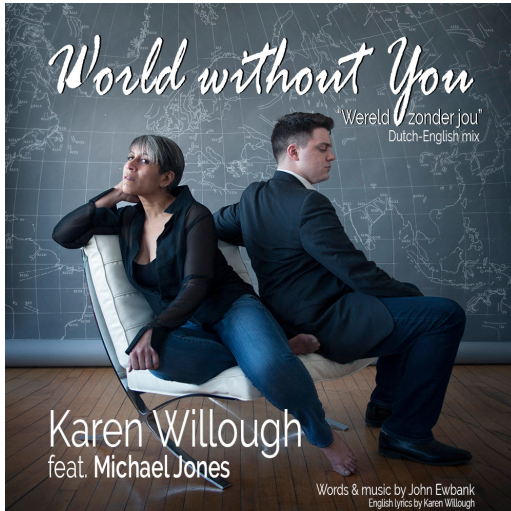

“World without you” (orig. title “Wereld zonder jou”) by John Ewbank was first sung by Dutch artists Marco Borsato and Trijntje Oosterhuis where it peaked at number three on the Dutch charts. Karen Willough, who lived in the Netherlands for several years, and is fluent in Dutch, translated the song.

Willough has partnered with multi-award winning international jazz musician **Michael Jones** for the duet, who also plays trumpet in the song. Produced by Billboard charting producer **michéal Castaldo**, it was recorded at studios in New York, Chicago and Rome.

Both Willough and Jones reside in Chicago and sing regularly with the Mount Carmel Morning Choir, under the direction of Paul French, Director of Choral Recordings for World Library Publications. They will be performing a concert together on April 30.

“World without You” will be sent to over 10,000 Adult Contemporary, World, and Easy Listening radio stations world wide; priority will be given to radio stations currently committed to support of Ms. Willough. (Visit website for listing.)

E-mailings to registered fans announcing the new release will be sent, as well as general press releases to media, and postcard distribution at venues where Ms. Willough and Mr. Jones will be performing in the upcoming months.

There will also be a video accompanying the release of “World without You” directed by Matthew Stubstad. Stubstad, who was recently interviewed on CNN, has directed a large assortment of commercials, music videos and short films.

Willough, a former board member of the Dutch Club of Chicago, and having dual citizenship with the Netherlands, will also be promoting the song at events via connections locally and abroad.

Award winning songwriter Willough is currently working with Castaldo on her next release, expected to be ready by Christmas 2016, which will be one of her original works.
